### MINUTES OF 9th UNION TERRITORY LEVEL BANKERS COMMITTEE REVIEW MEETING FOR DADRA NAGAR HAVELI, DAMAN AND DIU, FOR THE QUARTER ENDED MARCH 2022 HELD ON 30th JUNE, 2022.

The 9th UTLBC meeting of Dadra Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu for the quarter ended March 2022 was held on 30th June, 2022 at Conference Hall, Secretariat, Vidyut Bhawan, Daman. The meeting was Chaired by Shri Gaurav Singh Rajawat (IAS), Secretary, Finance (DNHDD) The meeting was attended by Sh. G.K.Paneri, General Manager, Corporate Office, Bank of Baroda, Shri Rajesh Kumar Singh, General Manager and Convenor, UTLBC, Shri Karanjit Vadodaria, Jt. Secretary Finance, DNHDD, Sh. Abhishek Sinha, DGM, FIDD, RBI, Sh. Sarat Panigrahi, DGM, Bank of Baroda, Sh. Arun Gupta, CO, DMC, Dr Narendra Singh, Professor, Navsari Agril, Univ., Sh. R.R. Patel, GM, DIC, Sh. Gaurav Kumar, DDM NABARD, Controlling Heads of Banks, officials and LDM's.

## General Manager, Bank of Baroda, Corporate office highlighted following important points:

- (1) It is observed that during the December quarter, advances has registered negative growth. It decreased by Rs.594.74 crores over March 2021 i.e declined by 9.72%. But in March quarter, branches in UT had made a good efforts to cover up the gap but could not cross the March 21 level by meagre 40 crores. Correspondingly there is a decline in CD ratio by 8.17 points over March 2021 and it requires attention of all stakeholders collectively. (Action: All Stakeholders)
- (2) Under the Annual Credit Plan, nearly 195% of annual target is disbursed, which shows that we are on the right track. However, focus is required on Housing and Education sectors. (Action: All Banks, LDM's)

### The Secretary, Finance, (DNH and DD) has given following observations/inputs:

(1) Aadhar Seeding: The Aadhar Seeding in PMJDY accounts is 87.56% and in operative CASA accounts it is 95.37%. All banks to make a roadmap to achieve 100% aadhar seeding in current quarter.

(Action: All banks, LDM, UTLBC)

(2) PM Svanidhi Scheme: In PM Svanidhi scheme, 531 applications have been returned by the banks due to various reasons. UTLBC to provide reason-wise breakup of these applications to UT administration.

(Action: UTLBC, LDM's,)

(3) Target allotment to banks: UTLBC to allot the Priority sector targets as per Lead Bank scheme to all banks in UT and also submit a copy to UT administration.

(Action: UTLBC,LDM's)


- (4) A meeting of bankers to be organised before conduct of main UTLBC meeting to discuss the performance of banks in overall parameters or poor performance of banks in particular segment/scheme, reasons thereof, roadmap to achieve targets etc.
  - (Action: UTLBC, stakeholders)

(5) Opening of branch at Kocha and Sindoli in Dadra and Nagar Haveli : Secretary Finance asked the banks to open FI branches at above centres before 15th August 2022.

(Action: All Banks)

## DGM , FIDD, RBI has given following observations/inputs :

(1) With regard to the low CD ratio in the UT of Daman & Diu and DNH, DGM, RBI requested that bank wise bifurcation may be presented in the UTLBC. Further, during the discussion on the low CD ratio of Diu district, he suggested that UTLBC may give its inputs regarding the



request for exemption of Diu from the requirements imposed on districts with CD ratio below 40%.

#### Agenda No. 3: Implementation of Financial Inclusion:

#### 3.1Aadhar Seeding and Social Security schemes:

Secretary, Finance asked to make concerted effort for 100% Aadhar seeding in UT. Bank wise data to be included in the presentation for individual review and identification of the lagging banks.

3.2 APY: Against the allotted target of 6210 enrolments' under APY, achievement is 5963 i.e.

3.3 Financial Literacy Camps: The Cooperative banks have not been allotted any target for conduct of FLC. Hence it may be excluded from the data

### Agenda No. 4: Review of Hon'ble PM Initiative Schemes:

<u>PMMY and Stand up India</u>: In PMMY, 2942 accounts for Rs. 49.13 crores have been disbursed during FY 21-22. Under Stand Up India scheme, 98 beneficiaries had been sanctioned loan worth Rs.31.83 lakhs



(Action: All Banks)

PM SVANidhi Scheme: While reviewing the performance under PM SVANidhi Scheme, it is observed that only 62.64% applications are sanctioned by the banks.531 applications have been rejected by banks. A breakup of this is to be provided to UT Administration.

(Action: UTLBC, Banks, LDM's)

Agenda No. 5: Review of Banking development in Key areas for the Quarter ended Mar 2022: The Priority Sector advance stood at 63.07% of NBC which is above benchmark level of 40%. But in Agriculture, it is 3.89%, i.e. below the benchmark level of 18%. Banks are requested to give a special attention on agriculture financing. Under Weaker Section advances, the achievement is 6.37% which is below benchmark of 11%. Under MSME's- micro lending, the achievement is 36.66% which is above benchmark of 7.5%.

Agenda No. 6: Progress under Annual Credit Plan (ACP) 2021-2022: The overall achievement in Priority Sectors disbursement under Annual Credit Plan (ACP) 2021-22 up to quarter March 2022, by all the Banks was 195% in respect of targets in amount and 92% in respect of targets in number of accounts. The highest percentage achievement in terms of amount was recorded in MSME – 270% followed by Agriculture – 142%, and Education – 88%.

# Agenda No. 7: Bankwise position of Outstanding, NPA, Percentage of NPA to Outstanding at the quarter ended Dec, 2021.

The Gross NPA of banks in UT is 2.98% and under Priority Sector it is 4.00% and in Agriculture, it is 3.05% as of Mar, 2022.

Secretary Finance requested banks to dispose off the pending applications at the earliest.


